Reiseplan

Day 1 - Your vacation begins in Egypt, Dubai, Abu Dhabi, and Kenya

Upon arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, your Tour Manager will be waiting for you. He will help you avoid long queues with a fast-track service, then you will be escorted to the hotel where you will spend the first night of your Egypt, Dubai, Abu Dhabi, and Kenya tour.

Once you check in at the hotel, your tour manager will review your itinerary with you and confirm things like pickup times and more. You will then be offered a complimentary "Welcome Drink" and the rest of the day is yours to enjoy at your leisure.

Day 2 - Full-day sightseeing in Cairo

The day will start with a wonderful breakfast at your hotel, then at 08:00 your personal guide will meet you at the hotel and take you on a fascinating tour of some of Egypt's most fascinating ancient Egyptian sights.

First, you will be transferred to the Giza Plateau to visit the Great Pyramids of Giza, the Sphinx, and the Valley Temple.

After this great start to your day, you will then be taken to a good restaurant to enjoy a delicious lunch.

After that, you will visit the magnificent <u>Egyptian Museum</u> and the impressive Treasure Room where you can see all the artifacts that were excavated from King Tutankhamun's tomb.

After spending some time in the museum, your tour will end with a visit to Cairo's famous <u>Khan El</u> <u>Khalili Bazaar</u>, then you will return to your hotel.

Day 3 - Travel to Luxor to start your cruise and tour the East Bank

Wake up to a good breakfast at your hotel, then at the time confirmed with you, you will check out, then your Tour leader will escort you to the airport where you will take a short flight to Luxor.

Upon arrival at the airport, one of our tour representatives will be ready to meet and greet you, then escort you to the port where you will board your five-star Nile cruise.

Shortly after boarding, you will be served your first excellent lunch on board, and after you and the other members of your group have finished eating, you will disembark the nile cruise for a tour of the East Bank of Luxor.

You'll first visit Karnak, the ruins of an ancient temple city. Although this sprawling site consists mostly of ruins, there is still plenty to see.

After your visit to Karnak, you will then be taken to see the <u>Luxor Temple</u>, another ancient temple that was not dedicated to any gods or goddesses. Spend some time exploring and taking photos, then it will be time to return to the nile cruise. Sit down to a wonderful dinner, and enjoy your first night's sleep in your luxurious cabin on the water in Luxor.

Day 4 - West Bank tour and sail to Edfu

Shortly after breakfast, you will meet, then you will be taken on a tour of the West Bank of Luxor.

Here you will visit one of Egypt's greatest treasures, <u>the Valley of the Kings</u>. This is an ancient royal necropolis where archaeologists have so far discovered more than 60 ancient tombs, including the tomb of Ramses II and the tomb of King Tutankhamun.

After visiting the Valley of the Kings, you'll visit <u>Queen Hatshepsut's</u> stunning rock-cut temple and then begin your way back to the nile cruise, stopping briefly along the way to see the thought-provoking statues of Memnon.

Once everyone is on board you will start sailing to Edfu where you will spend the fourth night of your tour of Egypt, Dubai, Abu Dhabi, and Kenya in your cabin on the water.

Day 5 - Edfu and Kom Ombo temples and overnight in Aswan

Once again, wake up on the river, and enjoy another good breakfast on board, then you will disembark to visit the best-preserved ancient world monuments at the <u>Edfu Temple</u> built to honor Horus, the falcon-headed god.

Return to the ship after your tour and enjoy a leisurely cruise to Kom Ombo where you will stop for another excursion, this time to see the Kom Ombo Temple; a magnificent ancient complex that was once dedicated to two different gods.

After your tour, you will return to the ship and enjoy lunch while sailing to Aswan where you will enjoy dinner and another peaceful night on the Nile.

Day 6 - Morning tour of Aswan and free afternoon

Once again, wake up again on the river and enjoy another good breakfast on board, then you will be taken to visit two of Aswan's very famous tourist attractions: The Giant Unfinished Obelisk, as well as the stunning ancient Philae Temple, built to honor two goddesses, Hathor and Isis.

After your tour, return to the ship for lunch and then enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure

Day 7 - Return to Cairo and free time

In good time, you will check out and disembark from the boat, then our tour representative and one of our drivers will transfer you to the airport to board your flight to Cairo for another night in the bustling Egyptian capital.

When your flight lands, you'll be met back at the airport and transferred to your hotel. Spend the remainder of the day as you wish and enjoy your last night in the land of the Pharaohs.

Day 8 - Goodbye Egypt, hello Dubai

As the next leg of your Egypt, Dubai, Abu Dhabi and Kenya adventure begins today, we will pick you up from the hotel on time so that we can transfer you to the airport in time for your flight to Dubai in the United Arab Emirates.

Upon arrival in Dubai, you will once again be met by one of our tour representatives and transferred to the hotel where you will be staying for the duration of your Dubai adventure. No sightseeing

excursion is scheduled today, so feel free to enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure to explore the sights of Dubai.

Day 9 - Dubai Heritage Tour and Dhow Dinner Cruise in Dubai Marina

Start day 9 of your Egypt, Dubai, Abu Dhabi, and Kenya tour with a good breakfast at your hotel in Dubai, then you will be taken to visit the 225-year-old Al Fahidi Fort located in the Bastakiya heritage area. You'll also visit the Dubai Museum located in the fort, then take a scenic ride across Dubai Creek on a traditional abra boat to visit the gold and spice markets.

After the fort, you will make your way to the beautiful Jumeirah Mosque built entirely of white stone, and from there you will transfer to Burj Al Arab where you will have some time to take photos before returning to the hotel for some free time. Later in the day you will be picked up again and taken on an unforgettable dinner cruise aboard a dhow in Dubai Marina, after which you will be dropped off at the hotel.

Day 10 - Afternoon/evening desert safari and sunset BBQ dinner

Enjoy this day on your own until around 15:00, when you will be picked up from your hotel and taken on a desert adventure by 4x4 vehicles.

Enjoy driving over several sand dunes and take in the views from the top of the highest dunes in the area. Try some sandboarding if you wish, then you will be transferred to a Bedouin campsite where you can enjoy some refreshments and even ride camels in the desert for a short while.

Day 11 - Sightseeing in Abu Dhabi and visit the Louvre Museum

On this day of your Egypt, Dubai, Abu Dhabi, and Kenya tour, you will be picked up very early and will be traveling to Abu Dhabi. Your first stop will be at the Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque which is the fourth largest mosque in the world, capable of accommodating up to 40,000 people.

Next, visit Etihad Square, then proceed to the Corniche, and then to the Heritage Village via Emirates Palace (external visit only). Your final stop of the day will be a visit to the Louvre Museum, then return to your hotel for your last night in Dubai.

Day 12 - Transfer to Nairobi, Kenya

Today marks the start of the final leg of your journey to Egypt, Dubai, Abu Dhabi, and Kenya, so we'll transfer you to Dubai Airport in time for your flight to Nairobi, Kenya.

Of course, when you land in Nairobi, we'll have someone there to meet you and drive you to the hotel where you'll be staying for the first night of your Kenya safari adventure. Once you check in, the rest of the day is at your disposal.

Day 13 - Game viewing safari

After breakfast on Day 13 of your Egypt, Dubai, Abu Dhabi and Kenya tour, you will be picked up from your hotel in Nairobi and set off on a scenic drive through the Rift Valley on your way to the Maasai National Park, Kenya's most famous and impressive nature reserve, known worldwide for the abundance of wildlife and diversity of species that inhabit the area.

The Masai National Park is also one of the best places to witness the annual migration of millions of wildebeest, zebras and gazelles making their way from the Serengeti across the Kenya-Tanzania border to the vast grazing plains of the Masai Mara, usually arriving in June. Interestingly, the lodge you'll be staying at for the next two nights of your trip is directly in the path of the annual migration, so if you plan to visit at this time of year, you'll be witnessing an event that no words can describe.

Of course, the park is also home to an abundance of other wildlife, including Africa's Big Five, and no matter when you book your combined Egypt-Dubai-Abu Dhabi-Kenya trip, you're sure to see the Big Five and more.

Day 14 - Free time in Maasai National Park

After all, your stay in the park also includes game drives, and you will be accompanied by a professional driver and guide who knows the park well. You can be sure that your guide knows exactly where to take you and when to take you so you can see Kenya's national animal, the African lion, as well as many other magnificent animals.

Your stay at the lodge will also be on a full board basis so you will also be able to look forward to 3 good meals every day. These two days will be two days that will likely make you want to come back.

Day 15 - Game drive and free time in Nakuru National Park

This morning you will leave Maasai National Park shortly after breakfast and travel to Nakuru National

Park, famous for its huge, shallow alkaline lake that attracts thousands of flamingos. However, the park is also home to many of the same species that inhabit Masai National Park, including the Big Five. Nakuru is also home to the very rare and endangered black rhino, which is not only protected, but also guarded.

Aside from the game-viewing safaris you'll enjoy here, you'll also love the tented accommodation, especially when you see the tents and step inside one. They're literally like 5-star hotel rooms, only better, and of course, they're basically tents.

Enjoy a great day, then enjoy a good dinner and a great night's sleep in the heart of the African wilderness.

Day 16 - Game viewing and free time in Aberdare National Park

Enjoy your breakfast and then you will leave Nakuru National Park and travel to Aberdare National Park, arriving in plenty of time before lunch is served. Once again, you'll have ample opportunity to spot some game or even try your hand at catching some local trout in the nearby rivers. This park is also a dream come true for anyone who enjoys bird watching as more than 250 different species can be found here

In the evening, enjoy a nice cozy dinner and enjoy the last night of your tour of Egypt, Dubai, Abu Dhabi, and Kenya as you listen to the sounds of nature as you fall asleep.
