Day 1 : Arrive to Cairo / Check-in / Overnight

Your tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will be waiting for you at [Cairo International Airport](#) to assist with the immigration process and you will be transferred in a private vehicle to the start of your fantastic Egypt trip.

When you get to the hotel in Giza, our tour guide will help you check in quickly and easily and go over your itinerary for [Egypt Travel Packages](#) to make sure that all pick-up times are convenient for both of you.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids Tour / Egyptian Museum Tour / Old Cairo Tour

After breakfast, you will be met by your English-speaking tour guide to begin your tour of the Giza [Pyramids](#). The Great Pyramid of King Cheops and the Middle Pyramid of his son [Chephren](#) are two of the world's oldest wonders that are still standing today. You will also see [the Valley Temple](#) of King Chephren, [the Great Sphinx](#), and the King Mycerinus Pyramid, which are all on the Giza Plateau, just outside of Cairo.

You will be taken to the Egyptian Museum, which has two stories and houses the largest collection of Egyptian artifacts in existence, as well as the one-of-a-kind golden treasure that was unearthed undamaged in the Valley of the Kings and was formerly owned by the young king Tutankhamun. He is one of the Egyptian family's eighteen parishioners, dating back to ancient Egypt. Tutankhamun, like many other pharaohs, is among the most well-known for reasons unrelated to his accomplishments or the victories he had in combat.

After that, we'll begin our [tour of Coptic Cairo](#) by going to the ancient Roman fortification of Babylon and [the Hanging Church](#), which is perched above the fort's two towers. You will visit Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is a historic Jewish synagogue situated in Old Cairo and Abu Serga Church.

Enjoy your meal at a reputable Egyptian eatery. After seeing the most well-known mosques constructed during the Islamic era and [Khan El Khalili](#), Cairo's historic bazaar. After finishing your Islamic Cairo tour, we will transfer you again to your hotel.

Day 3: East Bank of Luxor Tour

Get ready to check out of your hotel in Giza so that you can be transferred to Cairo International Airport to board a domestic flight to [Luxor](#), Egypt's tourism hub, where you will be greeted and assisted by a representative of our company. Set sail on a 5-star Egypt Nile cruise that departs from Luxor and ends in Aswan. Start the [East Bank tours](#) in Luxor after lunch on the cruise ship to see the magnificent [Temple of Luxor](#), which was built during the time of King Amenhotep III and finished by several rulers.

Your delicious dinner will be served overnight aboard your Egypt Nile River Cruise.

Day 4 : West Bank of Luxor

Our tour guide will meet you to start your [west bank excursions to Luxor](#) after breakfast on the Nile River cruise. Your first stops will be the enormous [Colossi of Memnon](#), the Valley of the Kings, and Queen Hatshepsut. On the west bank of the Nile River at Luxor, there is a supposed Egyptian mortuary [temple named El Deir El Bahari](#), also dubbed the Temple of Hatshepsut.

While floating near [Edfu](#), which is situated on the west bank of the Nile River in southern Egypt, take pleasure in your delicious meal.

Enjoy your fresh food-filled open buffet meal in the evening, then get ready for some entertainment,

including musical performances and belly dancing.

An optional [hot air balloon](#) ride over Luxor's beautiful historic ruins and the breathtaking Nile River landscape is a well-liked and breathtaking experience.

Day 5: Visit to The temple of Edfu and Kom Ombo

On board the Nile River Cruise, breakfast will be served. After that, set sail for Kom Ombo to see the magnificent temple there, which is home to several gods, including the crocodile gods Sobek and Haroeris, as well as the Edfu temple.

On the west bank of the Nile River near the city of Edfu, the Temple of Horus is one of the most comprehensive ancient Egyptian temples. The building of the temple took roughly 180 years. Then As the Nile cruise ship heads toward Aswan, enjoy your lunch, which is being provided to you.

Your dinner will be served on board while watching the Nubian Show, overnight at Aswan aboard your Nile cruise.

Day 6: Aswan sightseeing tour

You will enjoy a delicious breakfast aboard the cruise before heading to the beautiful city of Aswan to see [The High Dam](#) and the Unfinished Obelisk, which was most probably built by Queen Hatshepsut. [The Unfinished Obelisk](#), also known as the Incomplete Sink, is a pink granite engraved obelisk, the longest Egyptian obelisk, with a length of up to 42 meters, a weight of about 1,000 tons, and its name The Incomplete Obelisk is due to the fact that its construction has not been completed, as there is a large crack in its surface.

Enjoy your dinner and overnight on board.

Day 7: Disembarkation - Going back to Cairo

A fantastic opportunity to travel to [Abu Simbel](#) early in the morning by land or by air to see the most magnificent Egyptian temple that was constructed by Ramses II. (Optional Activity)

Your representative will transfer you to Aswan Airport so you can catch your flight back to Cairo on the final day of your Egypt Nile River Cruise after you have a delectable breakfast and check out of the cruise ship. Your private vehicle will take you to your accommodation in Giza after arrival.
