To explore the Abu Simbel temples, a well-known archaeological site situated on the west bank of the Nile River, specifically southwest of Aswan and considered one of the Nubian monuments, a bus ride from Aswan to Abu Simbel is the best alternative. Many thousands of tourists visit it each year, particularly on February 22nd and October 22nd.

During your excursion, you will have the opportunity to explore the great temple of Abu Simbel, which took almost 20 years to be completed after 24 years during the rule of the great King Ramsis and was specified to the God Amon, Betah, and was generally considered one of the most beautiful temples built during the rule of Ramses II and one of the most beautiful in all of Egypt.

The two temples were built from the mountains during the rule of King Ramisis II in the 13th century B.C., to be a permanent place for him and the Queen Nefertari, and for the celebration of the memory of her victory in the battle of Kadish, but in 1960 all the monuments were completely moved to another place. With us, you can plunge into the incredible history of Egypt.

Day Trip to Abu Simbel from Aswan

At 8:00 a.m., one of our friendly representatives will meet you at your hotel to start a fun-filled adventure to Abu Simbel from Aswan by comfortable bus.

Your excursion begins with an incredible visit to Abu Simbel Temples, In a feat of astronomical perfection, magic is performed twice a year on February 21 and October, when the sun passes through the temple at dawn to illuminate the gods' sculptures. The Temple of Nefertari, the adored spouse of the Pharaoh. This temple, which is smaller but equally beautiful, features six figures carved into the rock on its exterior, but it has nothing inside.

The four global gods—Ptah, Re-Her-Akhtey, Amun-Re, and Ramses II himself—are honored at the Temple of Ramses II. The Sun Temple of Ramses II is another name for the magnificent Abu Simbel temple. The smaller temple is devoted to Hathor, the cow goddess of music and love, and was constructed for his favorite wife, the Nubian Queen Nefertari.
