Cairo Day Trip to Giza Pyramids, Memphis and Saqqara

You will start your excursion to Memphis, which is considered one of the major capitals of ancient Egypt. It was associated with the establishment of unity between the Nile Delta and Upper Egypt during the time of King Mina, and remained the capital of Egypt during the Old Kingdom and the administrative and military capital during the time of the New Kingdom.

The idol of Memphis was the god Ptah, and his huge tomb stretched from Abu Rawash in the north to Lasht in the south, and possesses the most magnificent examples of Egyptian architecture and arts without dispute.

Then we will continue our excursion visiting the Giza Pyramids, an archaeological site in Egypt that includes the Great Pyramid, the Pyramid of Khafre, the Pyramid of Menkaure, as well as associated complexes and the Great Sphinx. These monuments were built during the Fourth Dynasty of the Old Kingdom in ancient Egypt, between approximately 2600 and 2500 BC. The site also includes several temples, Did you know that Cairo Top Tours will arrange everything perfectly if you book your excursions in Cairo with us? Memphis, regarded as one of ancient Egypt's principal capitals, is where your journey will begin. It remained Egypt's capital during the Old Kingdom and the administrative and military center during the New Kingdom. It was also linked to the unification of Upper Egypt and the Nile Delta under King Mina. It continued to serve as Egypt's administrative and military center under the Old Kingdom and the New Kingdom.

The most exquisite examples of Egyptian architecture and art may be seen at Memphis, which was home to the idol of the deity Ptah. His enormous tomb extended from Abu Rawash in the north to Lasht in the south.

Following that, we will continue our tour by going to the Giza Pyramids, an ancient site in Egypt that contains the Great Sphinx, the Pyramid of Khafre, the Pyramid of Menkaure, and other related structures. These monuments were constructed between around 2600 and 2500 BC during the Fourth Dynasty of the Old Kingdom in ancient Egypt. The location also has a number of temples, tombs and the remnants of a settlement of laborers.

After enjoying a delectable lunch at a neighborhood eatery in Cairo, we will continue our explorations by traveling to another well-known city. In the Arab Republic of Egypt's Giza Governorate, Saqqara is one of the towns that make up the Badrasheen Center. In Saqqara, some Egyptian aristocrats started constructing their tombs. The Director's Bridge, a mastaba constructed during the reign of Kha-Sakhmoy, the final king of the Second Dynasty, was one of the earliest royal buildings in Saqqara. Throughout the Dynasties, Saqqara's mastabas and pyramids were always being built.
