Journey to the exceptional Abu Simbel Temples which rank among Egypt's supreme archaeological treasures from a basic departure point in Aswan. Traversing from Aswan brings passengers to see the temples located by the Nubian desert which sits beside Lake Nasser.

More than 3,000 years ago builders chiseled Ramses II's Great Temple into the mountainside. A visitor will stand mesmerized before the temple's monumental front as Ramses II's four giant statues silently watch the landscape from their positions that exceed 20 meters in height. Inside you can see preserved ancient artwork that showcases Ramses' military victories and divine alliances.

The Temple of Queen Nefertari deserves your visit because it worships Hathor the goddess of love and music. This Temple represents Ramses's dear spouse by celebrating her life with exceptional artwork inside the temple that remembers her accomplishments. Timeless engineering achievements saved these temples at the dawn of the 1960s by moving them from looming submersion by Lake Nasser through an astounding feat of today's engineering expertise.

Tour to Abu Simbel from Aswan

The touring service of Cairo Top Tours organizes daily trips to visit Abu Simbel Temple which stands in the Aswan district as one of the works of King Ramses II the nineteenth dynasty ruler. The temples contain treasures from Egyptian art alongside architecture structures that show the prosperity of Egyptian empires together with New Kingdom Pharaoh divinity. A worldwide salvage operation performed under the direction of UNESCO and Egypt's government relocated the temples before Lake Nasser threatened their destruction.

Ramses II used his temple to honor four sacred deities namely Ptah alongside Re-Her-Akhtey and Amun-Re and himself. The Sun Temple of Ramses II is just as small and houses four worship areas dedicated to Queen Nefertari the Nubian and the Hathor deity Hathor and her role in music and love.

The Temple of Nefertari serves Nefertari with love because Ramses entrusted this monument to his wife. This slice-of-the-Temples hold images of six rock-carved gods on its front facade and hall spaces which match the grandeur of the bigger temple architecture. We finish site exploration at Deir el-Medina after taking memorable photographs before returning to Aswan at the tour's end.
