Edfu Temple, Aswan Governorate, the second largest temple in ancient Egypt, is one of the most famous monuments, especially in the city of Edfu, north of Aswan Governorate.

The Edfu Temple discovered the remains of colorful scenes and writings of priests written in the Demotic script, as well as traces of gold colors that were used to gild the reliefs of jewelry and royal insignia, as well as the bodies of the gods.

One of the best-preserved temples in Egypt, Edfu's most important feature is the famous black granite statue of Horus in the shape of a falcon, wearing the double crown of Upper and Lower Egypt. The Edfu temple includes a collection of inscriptions and drawings that record important information about the ancient Egyptian language, ancient Egyptian mythology, religious beliefs and worship practices.

Aswan governorate is home to a large number of temples that were built on the land of ancient Egypt and still contain secrets behind their walls and inscriptions. The Kom Ombo temple, located in the north of the governorate, is one of the most prominent temples due to its architectural and religious excellence.

Kom Ombo Temple was founded during the reign of Ptolemy VI, but the construction and inscriptions continued until the reign of King Ptolemy XIII and is one of the most important temples in Aswan and is an important tourist destination for all visitors.

Edfu Temple, which baffled scientists and explorers, and are still searching for its secrets. The latest discovery is that the texts in the temple indicate that some of its buildings were covered with layers of thick metal foils made of copper (gilded), of which only clusters of holes in the walls remain, which led to the scarcity of their documentation in archaeological records.

The discovery of an ink-painted demotic text that was completely hidden under the plankton, which talks about the priests entering the Holy of Holies, is a unique inscription as it is known that personal writings always appear in the outer perimeter of the temple or on the entrances and not in the main compartment or the Holy of Holies.

After that, you will be transferred to Kom Ombo Temple Kom Ombo contains many monuments in addition to this distinctive temple, including the area of the Chain Mountain, the Crocodile Museum, Al-Hosh area, Nagat Al-Hajar, Qorta, Rasras (Faris), Wadi Shatt Al-Rajal, and others.

The Kom Ombo Temple was constructed during Ptolemy VI. The Kom Ombo temple area is one of the most enjoyable archaeological areas to visit, where visitors can spend time between the beauty and splendour of the monuments represented in its famous temple and the adjacent Crocodile Museum, and the view of the Nile, which shines under the feet of this temple, coming from the south to irrigate Egypt, its land and its people with the freshest water.
