Private Tour to Karnak and Luxor Temples

The guide will pick you up from the lobby of your hotel to transfer you to the site of Luxor Temple. The historic temples in Luxor, in the eastern mainland of Luxor city, inside the most important temple on the Nile Corniche, the Luxor Temple and its entrance from the heart of Sidi Abu al-Hajjaj Square, which was built during the reign of King Amenhotep III to worship the god Amun-Ra, a temple that was built during the reign of King Amenhotep III to worship the god Amun-Ra.

Amenhotep could not rule Egypt because he was not the son of a former pharaoh or married to the daughter of a pharaoh who had previously ruled Egypt, the two conditions for ruling Egypt at the time, so one of his men advised him to build a huge temple to glorify and worship the god Amun-Ra to confirm his lineage so that he could rule the country, and indeed he succeeded in this by building the historic Luxor Temple.

After learning about the story of the Luxor Temple, you will be transferred to the Karnak Temple, which is connected to the Luxor Temple by the Kabash Road, which is 2.7 km long, through which the priests and kings walked in the Opt Festival, which began during the reign of Hatshepsut, and the goal of the Opt Festival was to meet the god 'Amun-Ra', the god of the Karnak temples, and the god Amun, the god of the Luxor Temple, with the renewal of birth, in addition to the re-crowning of the king and renewing his legitimacy to rule the country. After the end of your tour, you will be transferred to your hotel.
