It was customary for the king to start building the temple from the back to the front, as he started at the most important place, the Holy of Holies, where the statue of the idol was placed, so Seti started from the back to the front until he reached the first hall.

As for Abydos is an archaeological city located in the far south of Egypt in the Balina district of Sohag Governorate. As the people of Sohag call it 'the buried godmother' as a metaphor for the abundance of antiquities, the entire city is based on a number of temples and museums, as it was a pilgrimage destination for ancient Egyptians.

The Temple of Abydos. Seti I Temple in Abydos was built by King Seti I of the 19th Dynasty, who died without completing the temple and was completed by his son, King Ramses II. It was customary for the king to start building the temple from the back to the front, as he started at the most important place, the Holy of Holies, where the idol statue was placed, so Seti started from the back to the front until he reached the first hall.

After providing you with information about this temple, you will be transferred to the Temple of Dendera Temple, the temple was built by King Ptolemy III from sandstone, and many Roman emperors added modifications to it, so that the construction process lasted about 200 years, and it is characterized by unique architectural art rich in paintings and inscriptions, and its walls and columns are decorated with hieroglyphic writings and carved statues that are very accurate and beautiful, and the inscriptions on the interior walls of the temple show the Roman Caesars Augustus, Tiberius and Nero offering sacrifices to gods as the ancient Egyptians followed the practice of the ancient Egyptians.

At the end of your tour, you will return to Luxor to rest at your hotel after this long and interesting tour.
