The</u> two temples of Abu Simbel were cut into the mountain rocks by King <u>Ramses II</u> of <u>the nineteenth dynasty</u>, who built these magnificent temples for himself and his favorite wife, Queen <u>Nefertari</u>.

The temples of Abu Simbel are considered to be the treasures of ancient Egyptian art and architecture and evidence of the glory and majesty of the New Kingdom Pharaohs; they show the wealth of the Egyptian empire generated as a result of the military operations into Asian and African countries. The Egyptian government and UNESCO led an international salvage campaign to move the two temples of Abu Simbel, saving them from being submerged by the increasing water of Lake Nasser behind the high dam.

The Temple of Ramses II is dedicated to the four universal gods <u>Ptah</u>, Re-Her-Akhtey, <u>Amun-Re</u>, and to Ramses II himself. The great Abu Simbel temple is also called The Sun Temple of Ramses II. The smaller temple is built for his favorite wife, the Nubian Queen <u>Nefertari</u>; the temple is dedicated to the cow goddess of love and music, Hathor.

2 times every year, on February 21 and October, in an act of astronomical perfection, magic is done and the sun goes through the temple at dawn to illuminate the statues of the gods. The Temple of Nefertari, Pharaoh's beloved wife. of smaller size but similar beauty, the facade of this temple has six figures carved in the rock, and its interior also has nothing to envy that of the main temple.
