Initially, you'll go to The largest, the most important, and largest pharaonic kingdom in Egypt all represented by the [Temple of Karnak](#). From the Middle Kingdom to the Ptolemaic period, it provides a rich record of Egyptian civilization. There were many kings who constructed inside the Karnak Temples, but the New Kingdom kings like King [Ramses II](#) of the 19th Dynasty, [King Tutmosis III](#), Queen Hatshepsut, King [Amenhotep III](#), King Tutmosis I, Tutmosis II, and Akhenaton are considered to be the most significant.

[The Luxor Temple](#), one of the most famous attractions in Luxor. also, it's Unlike the other temples in Luxor, which were constructed for the worship of one of the [Gods of ancient Egypt](#), the Luxor Temple was not built for one god or a deity version of the king himself after his death. Consequently, you will be able to learn a lot of stuff in the temple.

The third stop on our tour is the [Luxor Museum](#), which we will take you to after that. In comparison to other Egyptian museums, the Luxor Museum displays a variety of collections of antiquities dating from the end of the Old Kingdom. In comparison to other Egyptian museums, the Luxor Museum is quite small, but it is a great place to learn about the history and culture of ancient Theba. Mummies, jewelry, sculptures, and Egyptian military artifacts are among the displays in this museum.
