The ground floor has the main entrance, an exhibition hall, a lecture hall, a VIP hall, security and administration rooms, and the museum's general manager's room.

The Philae temple:

The name "Phil" is due to the Greek word "Philai", which means "beloved", and it was known in Arabic literature as "Anas al-Wujud", in reference to the legend of Anas al-Wujud in the folklore stories "One Thousand and One Nights". As for the ancient Egyptian and Coptic name, it is "Bilak", which means the end or the end because it was the last frontier of Egypt in the south.
