Itinerary

Day1- arrive fayoum

Our tour guide will pick you up from your accommodation in Cairo in an air-conditioned car early in the morning and take you "about 95km" to the <u>Fayoum oasis</u>. The ancient Egyptians considered it to be the centre of cult love for the crocodile god Sobek. Around 200 of these gigantic waterwheels are dispersed around the oasis. You will first see The Great Seven Waterwheels, one of the symbols of the Fayoum oasis.

The next thing you'll see is "Qaron's Lake," which is also the biggest saltwater lake in Egypt and is considered to be the oldest natural lake in the whole globe. You may find different fruits and veggies around the lake as well as a breathtaking array of winter migration birds in the vicinity. It's a great place to unwind after a hot day of touring. You will then pause for a picnic lunch. After that, we went to "Wadi al-Rayan," which was declared a Protected Area in 1989. It's a great spot for a day trip filled with adventure and relaxation. There are several lakes that are ideal for swimming, leaping off of, or simply admiring the stunning natural surroundings.

Following that, we will return you to the Fayoum Hotel, where you will stay the night.

Day2- fayoum tour- back cairo

You will proceed to the "Wadi Hitan" Valley of Whales in the morning after breakfast. It was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in July 2005 because of the enormous quantity of fossils that have been preserved there that date back to some of the earliest forms of whales. Discover fossils from a time when the desert was inundated in water and dating as far back as 200 million years. The most prominent fossils are the skeletons and bones of whales and sea cows. Individual bones and whole skeletons of whales have been found as fossils, and several partial skeletons are presently on show in the park's open space.

Move a few hundred metres south of Wadi El Rayyan Road to Mudawara Mountain for a visit after finishing this beautiful tour.

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Although it is more of a rock formation than a genuine mountain, it has a gorgeous, layered appearance and an eye-catching symmetry. Then, you'll be driven to Karanis, a Ptolemaic-era city that is now a ruin. That city is home to a large number of Roman, Coptic, and Early Islamic monuments. afterwards we'll take you back to your hotel in Cairo.
