Itinerary

Day 1: Tour to Giza pyramids, Egyptian Museum

When scheduled, the tour leader will pick you up from the hotel lobby. drive to Giza next.

The guide will obtain the access tickets for you once you arrive at the <u>Giza plateau</u>. Once inside, you may just enjoy a once-in-a-lifetime event.

You will undoubtedly be in awe as you stand in front of the biggest, oldest, and best monument in the entire world, the only one of the Ancient Seven Wonders that is still intact.

Discover the Cheops, Chephren, and Mykerinus Great Giza Pyramids, with the option to enter one of them. The tour guide will undoubtedly assist you in taking stunning photos after that as you are driven to the panoramic view of the pyramids.

The journey also includes a stop at the <u>Valley Temple</u>, which is a part of King Chephren's pyramid, before continuing to the enormously mysterious <u>Sphinx</u> statue that dates back to his reign.

Lunch is optional after that. One of the top neighborhood eateries in Cairo or Giza can be suggested by the tour guide.

Then take a taxi to the center of Cairo to visit the <u>Egyptian Museum</u>, which is situated near Tahrir Square, where the 2011 valuation took place. Built-in 1902 was this museum. In reality, the museum contains relics from the Pharaonic age. The collection of artwork on display at the museum spans 5000 years and is thought to be the most priceless collection of Egyptian art in existence.

There are almost 5000 items on display, some of which date to the Greco-Roman period and others to the ancient, middle, and new kingdoms. The King Tutankhamun Treasury is among its features.

Drive then to Khan el Khalili's Old Bazaar to take a stroll. a chance to sample a regional beverage at one of Cairo's oldest café establishments.

You will be transported back to your hotel once we have ensured that your day tour of the Pyramids and museum was fantastic.

Day 2: Baharia Oasis and White desert tour

With our Egypt Tours, you may spend a day exploring the <u>Bahariya Oasis</u>. At 6 am, our tour guide will pick you up from your hotel and transport you to the oasis, which is located 360 kilometers southwest of Cairo.

Take a stroll around the oasis' historic village to admire the entrancing gardens of fruit and palm trees. Enjoy a vacation to the dunes, salt lake, and the Black Mountains.

Visit the renowned Mummies Hall again. When a donkey belonging to an antiquities guard working at the neighboring Temple of Alexander got its foot stuck in a pit, it led to the discovery of the <u>Golden</u> <u>Mummies</u> in 1996. The donkey ultimately learned to eat itself, but Abd El Maugud, the donkey's owner, alerted the Antiquities authority, leading to the discovery of the first golden mummies.

Visit one of the natural springs' water wells, either hot or cold, where you can have a bath and unwind. At dusk, make your way to the English House ruin on a hill to take in the expansive vista. Visit the village and shops in the evening before making the drive back to Cairo.

Day 3: Explore Alexandria

after breakfast, our tour leader Pick you up from your accommodation in Cairo or Giza at 7:00 am for the 220 km trip to Alexandria. Arrive in Alexandria at ten in the morning to begin your day trip, stopping at the Roman Theater (A theatre with marble seats up to 800 spectators, galleries, a section of mosaic flooring & a pleasure garden surrounded by Roman Villas and baths).

Then you'll go to <u>Kom El-Catacomb Shoqafa</u>'s a three-level gravestone that also has the Tri-cilium, where family members once sat on stone benches to feast the deceased. There are statues of Sobek and Anubis in Roman armor from the second century within.

After that, have a free stroll along the Cornish at El Mursi Abu Elabas, Qaytbay Citadel, and <u>Alexandria</u> <u>Library</u>.

You'll be taken back to Cairo at the end of the tour. You'll be back in Cairo at about 9:00 p.m.

Day 4: Final departure

Our tour guide will be there to pick you up in the hotel lobby at the scheduled time on the final day so you can be transferred back to the airport and leave Egypt with new experiences, stunning photos, and indelible memories.
