Itinerary

Day 1: Drive to Siwa

You will start your <u>Siwa oasis</u> journey from Cairo early in the morning so that you have time to explore Siwa before going to bed and getting ready for the next day.

Your tour guide will pick you up at 5 am (or later if you choose) and start driving to Siwa. You'll go through Alexandria to Marsa Matrouh, where you'll have lunch next to the Mediterranean Water, a location of the sea that is particularly outstanding due to its astounding colour diversity. The Mountain of the Dead, also known as (Gabal Elmwata), is a small hill close to Siwa Town's northernmost area that is covered in stunning wall paintings and honeycombed with rock graves. It is situated on Gebel al-Mawta, often known as the "Mountain of the Dead." Most of the tombs in this area were built during the 26th dynasty, along with the Ptolemaic and Roman periods. When the Italians stormed the oasis during World War II, the Siwans used these tombs as a refuge.

Next, proceed to <u>The Fortification of Shali</u>, a 13th-century mud-brick fortification where the Siwa people formerly lived. Although parts of the historic town's structures are still in operation, due to their construction from salt, mud, rock, and plaster, they decay much more each year.

Our next trip will be the Oracle Temple, also known as the Aghurmi or <u>Amun Ra Temple</u>. Alexander the Great travelled to the Greek-built temple after making his first foray into Egypt. (Amun Ra Temple).

We'll eventually arrive at Fatnas Lake. The little island of Fatnas in Birket Siwa is accessible by bicycle or foot. Gebel Bayda and Hamra provide a beautiful background to the west, making it a wonderful place to unwind and see the sun set across the lake. Banana, date, and olive trees, among other types, may be seen while strolling around the garden. After that, you will be transferred to your accommodation.

Day 4: Shopping, time for leasure and drive back to Cairo
