When thinking of Egypt, the most popular place around the world, the Giza pyramids are undoubtedly the first thing that comes to mind. No other country in the world has structures as magnificent as those found there, and the pyramids are almost the only building that is associated with as many myths. Regarding the building's intended use and the construction method, researchers continue to disagree. We'll take you to see the Great Sphinx of Giza, the Pyramid of Khafre (also known as Chephren), the Pyramid of Menkaure (also known as Mecerinus), and the Great Pyramid in Giza to learn more about these structures.

Greater Cairo is where the complex of the Pyramids of Giza is situated in the Arab Republic of Egypt. Additionally, you will see Saqqara Necropolis (Egypt's Oldest Pyramid), The Step Pyramid of Djoser, which is famous and draws many tourists to it during their Egypt tours. It is the oldest pyramid ever built among those attributed to Egyptian civilization. Up until the third dynasty, Saqqara served as the ancient Kingdom's royal necropolis. We'll also take you to the Ahmad Ibn Tulun Mosque, which is the oldest Islamic structure in Egypt, and then to the Gayer Anderson Museum.

our First destination is The Great Pyramid is just as impressive and large as you imagined. Many people agree that the Great Pyramid is not at all overrated, despite the fact that some famous places and attractions can let tourists down when they finally get to see them in person. At the start of historically documented human history, the Pyramids of Giza were constructed. there are a lot of things to do in the pyramids such as the panoramic point One of the best vantage points for the Giza pyramids is to see Six of the nine pyramids on the Giza Plateau.

also, you can talk a selfie with the sphinx Visit the viewing platform next to the Sphinx for a close-up view of the sculpture with the Pyramids in the distance. This is where you should take your "kissing the Sphinx" photo.

then our second point is Saggara

You'll go there to Saqqara The Step Pyramid of Djoser, the oldest pyramid ever constructed among those attributed to Egyptian civilization is what makes Step Pyramid famous. It served as the royal necropolis of the ancient Kingdom up until the third dynasty, and it is a popular stop for travelers on Egypt tours.

Additionally, Saqqara is home to a number of historical sites. The Step Pyramid, the Imhotep Museum, the Serapeum, the King Teti Pyramid at Sakara, the Mereruka Mastaba, and the Tomb of Ti.

then our third point is Ahmad Ibn Tulun mosque

The Ahmad Ibn Tulun Mosque, one of the earliest Islamic structures in Egypt built in 879, will be our next stop. It is regarded as one of the hanging mosques and was constructed on a rocky peak called "Shukr" on Mokattam Mountain. It features Egypt's first spiral minaret.

But if you're curious, What did Ibn Tulun's mosque serve? It provided refuge for pilgrims heading from North Africa to the Hijaz in the 12th century. The grand congregational mosque served as the focal point of Al-Qata'i, the capital of Ibn Tulun and the seat of the Tulunid dynasty. When you visit this mosque, you'll see that it's a unique example of a mosque that survived the classical Islamic era.

finally, we will take you to the Gayer Anderson museum

Gayer Anderson is an English officer who graduated from medical school in London and joined the English army's medical branch in 1904. In 1907, he transferred to the English army's service in Egypt.

The museum was made up of two Ottoman-era houses from the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries that had been combined into one house. He shows his archaeological collection of Pharaonic, Islamic, and Asian artifacts in them, under the condition that this furniture and his collection of artifacts pass to the Egyptian people upon his passing or upon his permanent departure from Egypt.

finally, we will take you to your hotel in Cairo or Giza. or Cario international airport.

Note: in pyramids, you can do additional activities (not included in our program) such as Going inside the greatest pyramid, Watching the Sound and Light Show the most popular show everyone enjoys visiting, The Sphinx, and the Pyramids are colored and illuminated every night. it tells the story of the pyramids for an hour.
