Cairo Top Tours expert team will meet you at Cairo International Airport upon arrival, the tour leader will be holding your name written on a signboard to make it easy to know each other, and your private vehicle and driver will be waiting to transfer you, and your private Egyptologist to the [Giza Plateau](#) where you will enjoy the tour of your lifetime.

Your guide will escort you to [Giza Necropolis](#), to view the single monument remains from the seven man-made wonders of the ancient world, the Great Pyramids of [King Cheops](#), the Pyramid of Khafre or Chephren, and the smaller [Mycerinus](#) pyramid, your [Egypt Day Tours](#) guide will teach you everything you need to know about the ancient Egyptian History and the religion in the life of ancient Egypt, see the famous [Great Sphinx](#) which is a traditional statue in [Egypt history](#) and had been imitated and used by the Roman and Greek civilizations, but here, the head of a man expressing the human mind and enlightenment, and the body of a lion pointing to the strength and fearlessness.

After that, we will take you inside the pyramid, there are three main chambers: the King's Chamber, the Queen's Chamber, and the Grand Gallery. The King's Chamber is the largest and most ornate, with a red granite sarcophagus where the pharaoh's body was placed. The Queen's Chamber is smaller and less decorated, and its purpose is still a matter of debate among archaeologists. The Grand Gallery is a long, sloping corridor that leads up to the King's Chamber.
