Itinerary

Day 1: Philae Temple - Aswan High Dam

Our Cairo top tours tour leader will greet you at your hotel or at <u>Cairo international airport</u> to assist you in obtaining your boarding pass for your Aswan flight, then you will be met by your private English-speaking tour guide upon arrival at Aswan Airport to begin your 2 Days Aswan overnight trip from Cairo by flight by visiting the High Dam in <u>Aswan</u>, considered the second largest dam in the world after the Chinese dam. It was constructed by president Gamal Abdel Nasser to generate electricity for Egypt and save us from the Nile floods that took place every year since the dawn of the <u>history of Egypt</u>.

Then continue your tour to visit Philae Temple which was devoted to the worship of the heroes of the famous myth, Goddess Isis, the wife of god Osiris, and mother of the falcon God of the sky, Horus who was also the protector of kingship. The temple includes archeological columns dating back to the Roman era, a rare cabin of King Negtanepo I, the temple of Hathor, and the temple of Imhotep, which dates back to the Ptolemaic era. You will have a delicious lunch in a good quality local restaurant before heading to your hotel in Aswan overnight.

Day 2: Abu Simbel Temples

After having your breakfast at your hotel on the second day of your 2 Days Aswan Overnight Trip from Cairo by Flight, you will meet your Egyptologist tour guide to start a once-in-a-lifetime trip to Abu Simbel Temples:

The two temples of Abu Simbel for King Ramses II and his wife Queen Nefertari are considered to be the most immeasurable monuments in Egypt after the Giza Pyramids, it's located 290 km south of Aswan, Ramses II built the Great Temple for himself, to commemorate his victory in the famous Battle of Kadesh, and then built the smaller temple for his favorite wife, Queen Nefertari.

After the Egyptian government established the High Dam, the Nile waters began to flood and cover the temple, and Egypt, with the help of UNESCO, decided to move the temple from its original location by cutting it into 4000 pieces and moving it to another place higher, and 34 countries participated in this great event.

Enjoy your lunch meal at a calm good quality restaurant and you will then be transferred to <u>Aswan Airport</u> for your flight back to Cairo.
