After that, we will head to Memphis, which was one of the ancient capitals of Egypt until about 2,200 BC. After the union of Upper and Lower Egypt, it became the first capital of ancient Egypt. In this open-air museum, you will find many temples and monuments dedicated to the god Ptah, the god of creation and works of art.
