To learn more about how the <u>Great Pyramids of Giza</u> were built, travel back in time approximately 200 years before the time of King Cheops, the owner of the Great Pyramid of Giza, whose fame continues to amaze scientists. Our <u>Cairo Day Tours</u> include a visit to the sacred necropolis of the ancient Egyptian capital of the Old Kingdom. Look out for the first perfectly shaped Red Pyramid and the <u>Bent Pyramid</u> at Dahshur, then the pyramid of Snefru, also known as the Meidum Pyramid, and look out for the most beautiful structures built nearly 4,700 years ago to perpetuate the names of the kings and rulers of ancient Egypt who founded the golden age of Egyptian history.

Visit the Giza Necropolis to see the Great Pyramids of Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus, as well as the Great Sphinx, a fantastic lion-like animal with a human head, and the Valley Temple of King Khafra, where the process of mummification took place as part of the funeral rituals. Lunch will be served throughout the Egypt Day Tours or at the end of your Cairo Trips. On a private day trip from Cairo, join a tour guide to Memphis, Dahshur.

The Egyptian Museum in Cairo has a large collection of artifacts and antiquities dating back to ancient Egypt and beyond.

You will have the adventure of your life when you book our Cairo Day Trip to Giza Pyramids and Dahshur Pyramids, which is one of our best tours and things to do in Cairo, Meet your private Egyptologist guide at the hotel lobby or any requested pickup location to be transferred by an airconditioned exclusive vehicle to the Giza Necropolis, where you will finally witness the remaining wonder of the seven ancient wonders of the World, the Great Pyramid of King Cheops who is the son of the builder of the first stone pyramid in history, Djoser.

See also the pyramid of Chephren, Chefren's pyramid was built half a century later than the central tomb and is located less than two hundred meters from it. the peak of this gigantic pyramid proves that the three pyramids in Giza used to have an outer-casing smooth surface which historians mentioned that the casing was made out of pure gold, the Great Sphinx, Unlike the pyramids that the Egyptians looked after, the sphinx was paid much less attention, so it was periodically covered with sand to such an extent that for many centuries it disappeared from the face of the earth until a ruler ordered the monument to be dug up. These works were so heavy that for a long time the Sphinx could only be partially freed from the sand, and it was completely excavated only in the twenties of the last century. The complex also has a Valley Temple for the king which you will visit from inside with your tour guide.

Continue your Egypt Tours to visit another necropolis that is not far from the Giza Necropolis, Dahshur, where other pyramids stand in glory to tell us that ancient Egyptian history was rich with impressive Kings and Rulers. located in the desert 26 km south of Cairo, on the west bank of the Nile, its area is 1.5 km3. Pyramids of the 4th dynasty, 12th dynasty, and 13th dynasty were found on the rocky plateau of Dahshur. Better than other pyramids in the area, the Bent Pyramid and Red Pyramid of King Senefru are well-preserved. Enjoy your gourmet lunch at the end of your Egypt Day Tours before being transferred back to your hotel by Cairo Top Tours vehicle.
