# Cairo stopover tours | Transit tour with stopover in Cairo

Cairo Top Tours accredited tour leader will pick you up from inside the airport terminal and you will recognize him by the sign with your name. He will assist you in <u>Cairo International Airport</u> with all the details to start your transit tour with a stopover in Cairo. You will be transferred to the <u>Giza day</u> tours to visit the only surviving monument of the seven wonders of the ancient world. Begin the tour with the Giza Pyramids of Cheops, which is built by the 2nd Pharaoh of the fourth dynasty of the Old Kingdom and the son of <u>Senefru</u>. Also, You will learn all the information about how pyramids were <u>built</u>, and why?, then you will view the opposite pyramids which belong to Khufu's younger son of <u>king</u> Khafra Chephren and the granite-cased pyramid of the last Pharaoh of the dynasty, <u>king Menkuare Mycerinus</u>. You will also see the <u>Sphinx</u> and the Valley Temple built for the embalming of the king's body for the afterlife.

Then we will transfer you to get fascinated by the treasures of the Egyptian Museum, which has a very particular collection of Egyptian antiquities from the <u>Pharaonic era</u> and the Greco-Roman era. The museum comprises more than 120,000 masterpieces including the statues of Ramses the second, Amenhotep The third, Thutmosis the third, and all the famous kings and rulers of ancient Egypt as well as the golden treasures of <u>Tutankhamun</u>. The museum also includes the treasures that were unearthed from various tombs and other objects. It was entirely protected under the sand for over 35 centuries till the tomb was excavated then it was entirely moved to Cairo to be seen through the Egyptian Museum tour.

After that, you will be transferred to have a delicious lunch in a local restaurant, and if there is enough time before the flight you will try our <u>Islamic Cairo trips</u>, where you can see the domes and minarets of the medieval mosques and the aged stone pavement of <u>El Moez street</u> date back to the 10th century, you will finish your <u>Cairo walking tours</u> with a drink at Fishawy, one of the oldest cafes in <u>Khan El Khalili</u>.
