Itinerary

Day Tour to Tanis Bubastis and the Suez Canal from Cairo

Start your fantastic Day Tour to Tanis, Bubastis, and the Suez Canal from Cairo, where our tour guide Cairo Top Tours will welcome you to begin your Egypt Day Tours. We will travel to Tanis, which was the capital of Egypt during the Ramesside period and was built from the beginning as the dwelling city of the Twenty-first Dynasty in Egypt.

<u>Amun-Ra</u> was honored by a large temple, as well as smaller temples dedicated to his wives, the <u>Goddess Mut</u> and <u>Khonsu</u>. It is a well-known biblical site in the ancient land of Goshen, where the biblical Exodus began. The basket with the baby Moses was discovered in the delta of its wetlands.

You will continue your Cairo Day Tours to Bubastis, also known as Per-Bast. This region was the cult center of the Cat-Goddess Bastet, one of the most important deities in ancient Egypt and the home city of the <u>Twenty-second Dynasty</u>. The main temple was dedicated to Bastet, originally a lioness goddess. The region also has some remains of temples for <u>King Teti</u> from the <u>Old Kingdom</u> and Pepi I.

Lastly, you will visit Ismalia to have your lunch and enjoy the Day Tour to Suez Canal from Cairo to see Suez Canal, which is one of the most significant international corridors, that helps to connect Europe with the oil-producing countries known as the Gulf countries, far east and India and saves above sixty thousand miles for boats instead of going around the cape of good hope in South Africa.

The canal facilitated trade between East and West and allowed importers and exporters to reduce the time and effort required to deliver goods between countries, prompting Egypt to engage in a series of battles with various countries vying for control of this key passageway, especially in times of war.

After finishing your trip, we will drive you back to your hotel in Cairo.
