Day Trip to see Luxor from Cairo by Plane

You will meet our <u>Cairo Top Tours</u> experienced tour leader at your hotel and he will take you to <u>Cairo airport</u> to start your thrilling Day Tour to Luxor from Cairo by Air. On arrival, our provisional guide will be anticipating you holding a signboard showing your name to start your day by visiting the <u>West Bank of Luxor</u> considered one of the most important archeological sites in all <u>things to do in Egypt</u> and in the whole world. the West Bank is a gateway to the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, located in the center of the mountains and the tombs are carved into the rock under the hills. The walls of the tombs are adorned with hieroglyphics decoration and writings of ancient Egyptian mythology and beauty. The Valley of the Kings is considered a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Then, we will move to <u>Hatshepsut Temple</u> also known as the temple of El-Deir El-Bahari (which means in Arabic the monastery of the stone) which was built during the <u>Eighteenth Dynasty</u> and dedicated to <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> and Amun-Re. The temple's unique design was made by the loyal architect Senmout. After that, you will stop to see the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, one of the most significant Luxor attractions facing the Nile River.

Resume your <u>Egypt Day Tours</u> to the East Bank of the Nile which is connected to the most famous attractions like the architectural complex of <u>Karnak temples</u>, which is considered the largest manmade religious complex the world has ever known. The largest temple of them belongs to <u>Amun-Ra</u>, Mut, and Khonso. The Egyptian rulers added their own architectural signs in the Temple to be remembered through the centuries.
