Itinerary

Your accredited tour guide will meet you anywhere in Cairo or Giza to enjoy a <u>Giza Pyramids</u> Saqqara and Dahshur Tour with Felucca on the Nile

First site

starting at the Giza Plateau to see one of the ancient seven wonders of the world, the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, as well as the pyramid of King Chephren with the Valley Temple where the royal corpse of the king was mummified prior to burial rituals, the Great Sphinx, which was believed to have been carved from bedrock stone to the same king with its appearance of a man-headed lion that denotes the strength of the Continue to the high plateau for a panoramic view of all three Giza Pyramids and a great opportunity to ride a camel there (optional activity).

Now it is time for tricky photos which can easily be done with the advice of your guide or the Bedouin guide who will catch amazing shots for you while kissing the <u>Great Sphinx</u>, holding the pyramids between your hands and etc., continue to visit one of the authorized papyrus institutes if we have sufficient time, there, you will learn more about how ancient Egyptians made the papyrus sheets which participated the most in creating such a magnificent civilization at the dawn of history.

second site

after that, you will visit <u>Saqqara</u> the oldest pyramid ever built among those attributed to Egyptian civilization that attracts many tourists to visit it, you will visit <u>the step pyramids</u> in Saqqara, the pyramids in Saqqara not built like the <u>Giza pyramids</u>, but instead of using massive stone blocks, they used a core consisting of Rubble or rough broken stones, With the support of his brilliant architect, King Djoser constructed the Step Pyramid, which amply demonstrates the evolution of the pyramid building. It has six steps and is the first significant cut-stone building of its kind in the world. <u>King Teti</u> the first king of the sixth dynasty, and the pyramid of <u>King Unas</u> which has the most spectacular burial chambers among all the pyramids (no extra ticket is required). You will visit one of the Mastaba <u>Tombs of the Nobles at Saqqara</u> to see the daily life scenes in ancient Egypt with all its activities and even the various corridors of the tombs.

third site

will transfer you to Dahshur, one of the most fascinating ancient Egyptian archaeological sites, where you can see the pyramids built by King Senfru, the creator of the 4th dynasty, and learn about their age (the old kingdom). The Great Pyramid and Khafra's Pyramid are the two largest ancient Egyptian pyramids, while the Red Pyramid is the tallest structure in the <u>Dahshur Necropolis</u>. You will also go to <u>the Bent Pyramid</u>, which was Snefru's second pyramid. The name given to this pyramid by the ancient Egyptians was "Sneferu is Shining in the South" or "The Southern Shining Pyramid," not the "Bent Pyramid."

the fourth site

then, we will take you to the sound and light show in the Giza pyramid. you will discover The secret land of Egypt, Giza, and its stunning attractions pyramids of Giza are which are wonderful at night during its educational and fascinating show for anyone who wants to know all the secrets, culture, and historical sites of Egyptian pharaohs. and at the end of this trip, you will Enjoy sailing down the river during the Felucca ride on the Nile.
