In the morning, begin your Cairo day tours to the <u>Giza Pyramids</u> and Sphinx. For one of our fantastic Cairo excursions to the Giza Plateau, where you'll learn about the pharaohs and how they built those pyramids, you'll meet our expert Cairo's top tour guide.

The only one of the original seven wonders of the world that is still standing is the Great Pyramid of King <u>Cheops</u>. King Chephren, King Cheops' son, also constructed the <u>Chephren</u> pyramid in the earlier era. See the Mycerinus pyramid, the only Giza pyramid made of both limestone and granite, which was constructed by King <u>Mycerinus</u>, the son of King Chephren.

Your next visit is the <u>Great Sphinx</u>, a well-known sculpture with a lion's body and a human head that was allegedly created for King Chephren to serve as a protector of the pyramids and to represent the king's wisdom and brilliance as a semi-god. the rest of your trips will thereafter be in Cairo, Egypt.,

Enter the <u>Valley Temple</u> of Monarch Chephren, which is situated in front of the enormous Sphinx. This is where the royal body of the king was embalmed during the <u>mummification</u> process.

then we will have lunch at a local restaurant in the area, then we will transfer to discover the precious treasures housed at the <u>Egyptian Museum</u> in Cairo, which has the largest collection of antiquities in the world, including artifacts from the Old Kingdom, Middle Kingdom, New Kingdom, as well as the Roman era. Included in the collection are the golden King Tutankhamun's treasures, which are thought to be the only intact royal treasure ever discovered. <u>Tutankhamun</u> is thought to be the son of King <u>Akhenaten</u> of the 18th dynasty and is thought to have been buried under the sand for more than 3500 years before his tomb was discovered in 1922. After that, it was completely moved to Cairo, where the Egyptian government displayed it all in the Egyptian museum.

after that Discover the breathtaking panorama of Cairo at night or the inviting daybreak on a felucca ride on the Nile in Cairo. Additionally, we may plan your birthday celebration while traveling across the Nile by felucca.

Then you will be transferred back to your hotel after you finish your Cairo trip.
