Your professional tour guide will meet you in your Cairo hotel to escort you to the <u>Pyramids</u>, where you will have an in-depth tour of the three Great pyramids, <u>the sphinx</u>, and the valley temple of King Khufu. Then we will transport you to have lunch in a nearby restaurant before transferring you to <u>Saqqara</u>.

Saqqara Step Pyramid is famous for being the royal necropolis of the ancient Kingdom up to the third dynasty; the <u>Step Pyramid</u> is the oldest pyramid ever built among those attributed to Egyptian civilization that attracts many tourists to visit during their <u>Cairo day tours</u>.

Then we will head to Ahmad Ibn Tulun Mosque. One of the oldest Islamic monuments in Egypt was built in 879.

And at the end of the day, we will transfer to Gayer Anderson Museum. The museum consisted of two houses dating back to the Ottoman era in the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries AD, and they were combined into one house, In them, he displays his archaeological collection of Pharaonic, Islamic, and Asian antiquities, provided that this furniture and his collection of antiquities become the property of the Egyptian people after his death or when he leaves Egypt permanently.
