You will enjoy an excursion to the Pyramids of Giza, the Great Sphinx of King Khafre, the owner of the 2nd Pyramid, and <u>the Egyptian Museum</u>, which is full of precious antiquities. Finally, we will take you back to the airport.

In Cairo, there is an amazing place called <u>Bab al-Nasr Cairo Gate</u>. It's a special place where you can learn about how people lived a really long time ago in Egypt. You can even pretend you are there and see all the amazing things they had a long time ago.

The interior of the pyramid has three burial chambers, one cut into the underlying rock and two at a height within the building itself, which is unique to the Khufu pyramid and something that no other pyramid has.

### **Itinerary**

## **Cairo Stopover Transit Tour**

<u>Cairo Top Tours</u> representatives will meet you at the <u>Cairo International Airport</u> terminal holding a sign with your name written on it to start your Cairo Stopover Transit Tour. Begin your day by visiting the famous Giza Pyramids during Layover, about one and a half hours from the airport to explore the Great Pyramid of King <u>Cheops</u>, <u>which</u> is the only monument among the seven man-made wonders of the ancient world that still remains almost intact. It was built during the <u>fourth dynasty</u> and the reign of King Khufu, who was the son of another great king called <u>Snefru</u> who built 4 pyramids for his burial without any evidence of him being buried in any of them. Those pyramids are the <u>Red Pyramid</u>, and the <u>Bent Pyramid</u>, and both of them are located in <u>Dahshur</u>, and the <u>Pyramid</u> of <u>Meidum</u>.

Then our tour guide will show you the other pyramids on the Giza plateau, the pyramids of <u>Chephren</u> ( the second reigning son of Khufu), and finally the third pyramid and the smallest built for the funeral of king <u>Mycerinus</u>. you will also visit the grand <u>Sphinx</u>. We will resume visiting <u>the Valley Temple</u> or the mummification temple of King Chephren.

You will enjoy an interesting <u>camel ride around Giza Pyramids</u> (optional activity) from the panorama guided by the local Bedouins with a clear view of the <u>Giza Pyramids</u> in the background.

We will continue our <u>Cairo Airport Tours</u> by visiting the treasures of the <u>Egyptian Museum</u> in Cairo, which consists of two floors and is located in the famous Tahrir Square. the museum displays artifacts dating back to different periods of ancient Egyptian history 6000 years old. More than 120,000 masterpieces are displayed which means spending only one minute in front of each item you will need above six months to browse the museum completely, among the most interesting artifacts are the Tutankhamen collection of gold and jewelry that were hidden under the sand for over 35 centuries till his tomb was found in 1922 by Howard Carter, then it was completely moved to Cairo to be displayed inside the museum.

Have your lunch in a Pyramids views restaurant. After that, if you have enough time before the flight we will take you to enjoy a <u>walking tour</u> of the Islamic district of Cairo, to see the old walls surrounding Cairo and the old gates of this 1000 year old city and its oldest street, called <u>Street of El Moez</u> date back to the 10th century. Enjoy your tea at Fishawy's oldest cafe in <u>Khan El Khalili</u>, one of the oldest still operating bazaars in the Middle East.
