You will first go to [Giza Pyramids](#) the journey will surely come to mind first. No other country in the world has structures as marvelous as those there and almost no other building in the world is associated with as

many myths as the pyramids. To this day, researchers are divided over the purpose for which it was built and how the building itself was realized.

After that, you will visit The well-known [Step pyramid](#) of Saqqara is regarded as the world's first substantial carving in stone. It is, as its name implies, a sequence of six levels of progressively smaller stones that rise to a height of 62 meters (200 feet).

Following that, you will go to Of Dahshur's three principal pyramids, [the Red Pyramid](#) is the tallest. His moniker derives from the reddish-rust color of the area's red limestone. The third-largest Egyptian pyramid, located in the city of Giza, was constructed later. The Red Pyramid was the world's highest stone structure when it was first built. The pyramid of bats is how the locals refer to it.

Next, you'll go to [The Bent Pyramid](#), which is One of the three pyramids Senefru erected as the leaning pyramid. He began building the pyramid at an angle of 58 degrees, and when it had almost reached half its height, it was decided to erect the top at an inclination of 43 degrees, giving it the nickname "leaning pyramid." With the aid of cutting-edge technology, the Red Pyramid at Meidum has been completely constructed thanks to this method.
