Alexandria boasts several attractions, including the Qaitbay Citadel, Bibliotheca Alexandrina, the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, Montaza Palace, Pompey's Pillar, the Corniche Promenade, and the Naval Museum. These sites offer stunning views, a rich collection of books, and local cuisine.

A few tourist sites in Alexandria are the Maritime Museum, the <u>Library of Alexandria</u>, the Kom El Shokafa Catacombs, Montazah Palace, the Bombay Pillar, and the Qaitbay Fortress. Along with a wide variety of books and regional food, these locations provide stunning views.

You will arrange a suitable pick-up time with your operator. Start your day Tour there by visiting the <u>Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa</u> (Tombs on three levels, also contains the Tri-cilium where relatives used to sit on stone benches to feast the dead, a center with relieves of bearded serpents, Inside are 2nd Century AD statues of Sobek &Anubis wearing Roman Armor).

These tombs represent the last great existing construction for the ancient Egyptian religion and they also represent the beauty of Roman art in Egypt, which makes these tombs very unique in their kind.

1day trip to Alexandria from Alexandria

Next, we will move to <u>the Roman Theater</u>. Also referred to as the Roman Amphitheatre, the site dates to the 2nd century A.D. Unearthed during excavations in 1960, this well-preserved Roman Theater features galleries, sections of mosaic flooring, and marble seating for up to 800 spectators.

Then you will visit **Alexandria Library**, It was founded at the beginning of the 3rd century BC. by the Pharaoh Ptolemy I (Soter) who was one of the most famous rulers of the Ptolemaic period, and extended by his son Ptolemy II Philadelphus, but in later times its importance was diminishing and its collections were lost, due to the changes in power and successive invasions. Then, visit <u>Pompey's</u> <u>Pillar</u>, the only remaining pillar from the Roman temple which stands tall on a rocky plateau in the surrounding ruins of the Serapeum.

Continue to see the outside of Quaitbay castle which was built on the same site as the ancient Lighthouse of Alexandria one of the seven wonders of the world and a great photo stop. Next, visit the Royal Jewelry Museum. Your tour will conclude with a drive along the Mediterranean coast to the Montaza Gardens, which feature 115 acres of gardens surrounded by great walls on three sides and the sea. Within its walls, you will see the exterior of the Montazah Palace, built-in 1932 by King Fouad and inherited by his son King Farouk, the last of the Egyptian kings. As you drive through the gardens, photo stops will be made along the way.

And on your way back, stop over the famous Stanley Bridge – the landmark of modern Alexandria where you can have a free walk before going back to the hotel.

Lunch is included in between visits at Local Restaurants Based on a full meal for each person.
