Itinerary

Day 1: Marsa Alam/ Pyramids Tours

Cairo Top Tours representative will pick up you from your hotel to enjoy your Cairo Tours from Marsa Alam by flight.

You will be transferred by a private a/c new vehicle to Hurghada Airport for your flight to Cairo. Arriving at Cairo Airport where your Egyptologist guide will meet you to discover the <u>Giza Pyramids</u> area. Pyramids of <u>Cheops</u>, Chephren, and Mycerinus. Then continue to visit the Great Sphinx which dates back to the era of <u>Chephren</u>; the sphinx is a mythological lion figure with the head of a man to symbolize the cleverness and the strength of the ancient Egyptian Pharaohs, then visit the Valley Temple, which belongs to the Pyramid complex of Chephren. Lunch will be served in a local restaurant. Move on to visit the <u>Step Pyramid</u> of Zoser at <u>Saqqara</u> necropolis, the world's oldest stone structure. It was built in the 3rd dynasty during the old kingdom of ancient <u>Egypt history</u> for King <u>Dioser</u>. Then transfer to your hotel in Cairo Overnight.

Day 2: Cairo Tours/ Back to Marsa Alam

Breakfast at your hotel before continuing your overnight Cairo Tours from Marsa Alam to enjoy an excursion to the Egyptian museum which features artifacts from the Pharaonic period. The museum displays a rare collection of 5000 years of art which is considered the largest and most precious collection of Egyptian artifacts in the world. Over 250,000 genuine artifacts are presented, including Tutankhamun's collection of treasures, gold, and jewelry which were enclosed in his tomb for over 3,500 years.

Lunch will be served in a good-quality restaurant in Cairo. Then proceed to visit Saladin Citadel, The Alabaster mosque of Mohamed Ali which was designed by the architect Yousif Boushnaq, a Turkish man who came especially from Istanbul to build this great mosque for Mohamed Ali, the ruler of Egypt (1805-1849) who ruled Egypt over 45 years. but he did not make it to complete the construction of his huge mosque that looks very similar to the blue mosque in Turkey, his son and successor Ibrahim Basha was the one who completed the mosque after his father's death

Continue driving to <u>Islamic Cairo</u>, where you will be able to explore Khan El Khalili, Cairo's old bazaar. Finally, you will be transferred to Cairo Airport for a flight back to Hurghada. Upon arrival at Hurghada Airport, you will be transferred back to your hotel/ resort in Marsa Alam after your 2 Days Trip to Cairo is over.
