Explore Luxor Day Trip from Taba by Flight, our Cairo Top Tours tour leader will greet you at your Taba hotel and accompany you to Sharm Airport for your [Egypt Day Tours](#) to Luxor from Taba.

You will catch your flight to Luxor, and there you will meet another assistant to assist you at the airport, then you will meet your authorized tour guide who will be with you all day to start your day trip to Luxor from Taba to visit [Karnak Temple](#), which was the largest administrative and religious center in the world. Proceed to enjoy a tasty lunch meal then continue to visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir Al-Bahari or the northern monastery in the English language, the Mortuary temple was built for the honor of the Theban triad of [God Amun](#), Goddess [Mut](#), and their son, god of the moon, Khonso. Now you will see the only remains of the Temple of [Amenhotep III](#), [Colossi of Memnon](#). When you finish you will transfer back to [Luxor Airport](#) to take the flight to Sharm El-Sheikh then transfer to your hotel in Taba.
