Giza Governorate is characterized by the spread of ancient Pharaonic monuments, which made it one of the first governorates to attract tourists, as it is considered second in ranking after Luxor city in terms of Pharaonic monuments, the most important of which are the Pyramids of Giza, the Sphinx, the Sound and Light Project, the Saqqara Pyramid, and Khufu's funerary boat.

Your guide will transfer you from your construction to start out the exciting day tour to the repository of Memphis, to ascertain the alabaster sphinx, the second-biggest sphinx sculpture from Ancient Egypt and it's created out of an eighty tons block of marble, thus the massive rock sculpture of king Ramses II of the nineteenth people the simplest builder and king of the New kingdom.

then our licensed guide will take you to Dahshur one of the foremost attention-grabbing social science sites from ancient Egypt where you get to see the pyramids of king Senfru the founding father of the 4th people, and thus the age of the pyramids (the previous kingdom). The Red Pyramid, which is the highest in Dahshur necropolis and the third largest ancient Egyptian pyramid, size of this pyramid is barely engulfed by the Great Pyramid and Khafra's pyramid. you'll to boot visit the Bent Pyramid, which was the second pyramid designed by Snefru. the normal Egyptians didn't call this pyramid the "Bent Pyramid", their name every "Sneferu is Shining among the South" and "The Southern Shining Pyramid".

at the highest you may have a sailboat tour for AN hour then you'll be transferred back to your Hotel.
