## **Day tour to Cairo**

In the morning the tour leader will meet you in your hotel and then will take you to enjoy your tour in Cairo.

You will first go to One of the most recognizable structures in Islamic Cairo and one of the most impressive defensive fortresses from the Middle Ages is the Citadel of Sultan Salah al-Din al-Ayyubi (Saladin). Its advantageous position atop the Muqattam Hills provided it with a strong defensive position and unhindered views of Cairo, which it continues to provide even today.

After that, you will visit the national museum, The NMEC is a first for Egypt and the Arab region. It

focuses on the continuity and stability of Egyptian civilization as evidenced by its tangible and intangible heritage and presents the full range of its richness and diversity throughout the ages, from prehistoric times to the present. The royal mummies, which are part of the museum's exceptional collection, are on display in a new interactive installation that uses cutting-edge technology from the twenty-first century to peek behind their wrappings and reveal their secrets as well as explain the rituals and religious beliefs associated with mummification in ancient Egypt.

Then you will eat your dinner and you will take a Felucca ride in the Nile to experience the Nile in Cairo and the tour leader he will return you back to your hotel in Cairo.
