Memphis, Saqqara, and Dahshur Wheelchair Accessible Tours

Cairo Top Tours representative will meet you anywhere within Cairo or Giza to enjoy the private wheelchair-accessible tour to Memphis, Saqqara, and Dahshur Pyramids. You will start with the Step Pyramid in Saqqara, which is considered to be the largest and oldest stone structure in the world. It was built during the <u>3rd dynasty</u> for King Djoser who was a great ruler among <u>the kings of Egypt</u> learn more about the history of Egypt.

After that, transfer to <u>Memphis</u>, which was founded by King Menes, who was the real founder of the dynastic <u>history of Egypt</u> after unifying the two lands of Upper and Lower Egypt to start the 1st dynasty, Memphis was the capital of Egypt during the <u>Old Kingdom</u>, the first capital of Egypt was considered a center of government and culture for over 3000 years, and to see the statue of King Ramses II who is one of the most famous kings during the new kingdom, and the Alabaster Sphinx of Memphis.

Then drive to Dahshur, two of the subsequent pyramids built here have been completely destroyed by time, and the elements and many others, such as the black pyramid (12th dynasty), are badly damaged, but Dahshur also boasts two of the earliest pyramids in Egypt. Both built during the reign of King Sneferu, the founder of the 4th dynasty and the father of King Cheops who built the biggest of the pyramid of Giza, the Bent Pyramid and the Red Pyramid in Dahshur are massive evidence of the architectural development leading to the construction of the Great Pyramids in Giza. Then drive to your hotel after having a gourmet lunch meal of the best Egyptian cuisine on our way back.
