### Wheelchair Accessible Tour to Giza Pyramids and Sphinx

Meet Cairo Top Tours tour leader anywhere as advised during the agreement and start an amazing Wheelchair Accessible Tour to <u>Giza Pyramids</u> and Sphinx accompanied by your personal tour guide and a suitable vehicle with a driver. During the day, you will get to know a lot of things you maybe never heard about before, even if you read or saw a documentary about the Egyptian civilization, we are sure that the atmosphere of being here, at the most sacred place for ancient Egyptians during the <u>old kingdom</u>, specifically the 4th dynasty that was built by the descendants of King Snefru who already owns 3 pyramids in which 2 of them are located in <u>Dahshur</u>.

His son, King Khufu, or as he's known now by the name Cheops, constructed the biggest burial tomb ever, standing at a height of 146 meters and 230 meters long on each side, nothing could beat this height except after the construction of the Lincoln Cathedral in 1072 A.D as records say, so you can imagine that immense building stood for almost 3600 years as the tallest structure on earth.

Your personal Egyptologist guide will tell you each and every tiny detail you could have imagined while standing in front of the pyramid and exploring the other two pyramids of <a href="Chephren">Chephren</a> and <a href="Mycerinus">Mycerinus</a>, Chephren owns the most complete funerary complex, including the Great <a href="Sphinx">Sphinx</a> and the Valley Temple where his royal body mummified before burial, the Sphinx of Giza resembles power and wisdom, as it was carved on the shape of a man-headed lion which is 73 meters long and almost 23 meters high, historians got confused about to whom this statue was cut from the bedrock, but being within the pyramid complex of Khafra makes it good evidence to be made for his majesty. At the high plateau, you will have the chance to take breathtaking photos of the whole plateau.

Transfer back to your hotel or any other chosen drop-off location at the end of your Giza Pyramids tour for the disabled.
