Giza pyramids:

The most important of these pyramids is the Great Pyramid or the Pyramid of Khufu, which is the only surviving monument of the Seven Wonders of the World. It is located in the Giza pyramids area in Egypt, which is registered as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The construction of the pyramid dates back to about the year 2560 BC when it was built as a tomb for the fourth dynasty pharaoh Khufu, and its construction continued for a period of 20 years.

Saqqara:

The museum includes wonderful statues of the great kings, Khufu, Khafre, and Menkaure, the builders of the pyramids on the Giza plateau.

Old Cairo:

There are many archaeological sites in ancient Egypt, such as the Hanging Church, which is one of the oldest and most ancient churches in Egypt, and the Amr Ibn al-Aas Mosque, the oldest mosque in Africa, in which the last ten nights of Ramadan are celebrated.
