On this tour, our start will be at [Giza Pyramids](#), There are three main pyramids at the Giza complex: the Great Pyramid of Khufu (also known as Cheops), the Pyramid of Khafre (or Chephren), and the Pyramid of Menkaure. These massive structures were built as tombs for pharaohs and their consorts and were constructed using millions of limestone blocks that were quarried and transported from nearby sites. Also, you will be able to discover what is inside the pyramid of Khufu, and you will see the King's Chamber and a lot of things. After that, you will ride a camel in the Sahara desert, in addition to our lovely lunch that you will enjoy it.

In Giza there is [The Red Pyramid](#) is the tallest of the three main [pyramids of Dahshur](#). His name came from the rusty reddish tint of its red limestone. It's the third-largest Egyptian pyramid, which was built later in the city of Giza. You can visit it during your tour.

A representative of Cairo Top Tours will take you from your hotel in Hurghada to Hurghada International Airport to Cairo, when you reach Cairo there is a private air-conditioned car with our tour guide speaking English that will take you to start your journey in Cairo.

The tour commences with a trip to the Giza Plateau, where you can view the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, one of the ancient seven wonders of the world, along with the pyramid of King Chephren and the Valley Temple, where the mummification of the king's corpse occurred before burial rituals. The Great Sphinx, which is said to have been sculpted from bedrock in honor of the same king and features a man-headed lion, symbolizing strength, will also be visited. You will then continue to the high plateau for a panoramic view of all three Giza Pyramids before indulging in a camel ride around them.

also, on this trip, we will take you inside the pyramid, there are three main chambers: the King's Chamber, the Queen's Chamber, and the Grand Gallery. The King's Chamber is the largest and most ornate, with a red granite sarcophagus where the pharaoh's body was placed. The Queen's Chamber is smaller and less decorated.

After that, you will enjoy a camel ride in Giza is a unique and popular activity for visitors to Egypt. The Pyramids of Giza make for a stunning backdrop as you ride through the desert on the back of a camel.

There are several free activities you can do at the Pyramids of Giza in Cairo, Egypt. Here are some suggestions:
