You will first visit <u>Karnak Temple</u>, which is both one of Egypt's largest pharaonic kingdoms and one of the country's biggest temples. From the Middle Kingdom to the Ptolemaic period, a period of about 2000 years, it provides a rich record of Egyptian civilization. The vast Karnak temple complex is one of the oldest places in the entire country of Egypt.

The Temple of Luxor, which is situated on the eastern bank of the Luxor River, is the second location

we'll take on your trip. In 1400 BC, Amun-Ra converted it into a place of worship, and his wife Mut constructed the Luxor temple. It is abundantly clear from the Egyptian temple that this is one of the most exquisite and well-preserved Egyptian temples.

Following that, you will go to the <u>Museum of Luxor</u>, which is comparatively small compared to other Egyptian museums but serves as a superb illustration of ancient Theba's culture and history. Mummies, jewelry, sculptures, and Egyptian military artifacts are among the displays in this museum. One of the most priceless pieces in the collection is a reconstruction of an Akhenaten-era wall from the temple of Karnak, where you can see his unique artistic vision.
