Our tour guide will pick you up from your Luxor hotel in a modern, air-conditioned vehicle, then transfer you to The majestic Temple of <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> was built by the only pharaonic woman to rule ancient Egypt, Queen Hatshepsut, daughter of Thutmosis I, who ruled Egypt for about 20 years during the 18th Dynasty 1490–1469 B.C.

After that, proceed to the majestic <u>Valley of the Queens</u> to see the Great Queen Nefertari's tomb. The day visits will come to an end at the Tombs of the Nobels, which contain more than 400 tombs of aristocratic people. These tombs were embellished with obscure Book of the Dead passages to help the deceased navigate the afterlife.

then we transfer to have lunch at a local restaurant after that Continue your tour of the Luxor Mummification Museum. This small museum, which first opened to the public in 1997, features human and animal mummies as well as tools used in the mummification process. It also explains the art of mummification, a practice that the ancient Egyptians thought was essential for achieving eternal life. It also features examples of the kinds of items that were traditionally interred with the dead.

After these wonderful visits, you will be transferred back to your Hotel in Luxor.
