Visit the city that served as the capital of the "<u>New Kingdom Pharaohs</u>" (1570–1090 BC), which is home to the greatest concentration of historic archaeological sites in the Nile Valley.

The <u>East and West Banks of the Nile</u> are home to the most significant sites. The stunning Temple of Karnak is located on the East Bank, which is known as the "City of the Living." The Colosseum of Memnon, the Valley of the Kings, and the breathtaking Queen Hatshepsut funerary temple are located on the West Bank, which is known as the "City of the Dead." We'll basically be doing two fantastic tours in one day when we go from East Bank to West Bank!

You will have ample time and if you would like to book an extra ticket to visit the tomb of the golden Pharaoh Tutankhamen you can simply ask the tour guide to help you with that, finally, you will stop to take pictures of <u>the Colossi of Memnon</u>. The only surviving standing statue from the demolished mortuary temple of Amenhotep III who was the father of the famous King <u>Akhenaten</u>, then you will be transferred to Luxor Airport for the flight back to Sharm El Sheikh.

Upon arrival in Sharm, our tour leader and driver will take you back to the hotel.
