Itinerary

Day 1: Sharm El Sheikh to Luxor - East Bank Tours

Relish your Nile Cruise from Sharm El Sheikh from the time you will be met by Cairo Top Tours tour leader from your hotel in Sharm El Sheikh then you will be transferred to Sharm El Sheikh International Airport to take your flight to Luxor, upon arrival you will be met and assisted by our tour leader there, he will transfer you to board your Egypt Nile Cruise Tours before lunch.

After having your lunch aboard the cruise ship, start your <u>Luxor East Bank tours</u> starting with the <u>Karnak</u> Temple which was built to be a natural museum of ancient Egyptian art, it was the center of religion and power during the peak of the <u>new kingdom</u>. Then head to the Temple of Luxor, which is another example of the greatness of the country during the new kingdom of <u>Pharaohs of ancient Egypt</u>. The temple was built by many kings like <u>Amenhotep III</u> and Tutankhamun.

Then you will relax in your boat and have a free evening before your delicious dinner meal is served in the boat's restaurant. Live peace of mind on your 1st night of your Egypt Nile River Cruise in <u>Luxor</u>.

Day 2: Luxor West Bank Tours

Enjoy your breakfast aboard the boat, then start your <u>Luxor West Bank tours</u> to the <u>Valley of the Kings</u> where you can see a lot of royal tombs of <u>kings and pharaohs of Ancient Egypt</u>, then visit the <u>Al Deir Al Bahari Temple</u> that was built during the reign of Queen <u>Hatshepsut</u>, the second female ruler in Egypt.

And the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u> which are two enormous colossal statues of the Pharaoh <u>Amenhotep III</u>, who reigned in Egypt during the <u>18th dynasty</u>, lunch is served aboard the cruise boat and then sailing to Edfu, overnight in Edfu.

Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

After having your breakfast aboard your cruise vessel, you will go to visit the <u>Temple of Edfu</u> which was built for the worship of <u>Horus</u> the falcon god and son of Osiris and Isis, then continue the sailing to Kom Ombo, lunch will be served aboard the boat, in the afternoon you will visit <u>Kom Ombo temple</u> dedicated to the crocodile God Sobek that the local people symbolized it in a new figure called God Horaeris, and then sail to <u>Aswan</u>, dinner aboard the ship and overnight at Aswan.

Day 4: Aswan Sightseeing Tour

After taking your breakfast aboard the boat, you will start your <u>Aswan excursion</u> by visiting <u>the High Dam</u> of Aswan, which protected Egypt from annual floods and generates electric power in modern <u>Egypt. Today</u>, after the Chinese dam, also visit the Unfinished Obelisk, which is the largest known ancient obelisk. <u>Philae Temple</u> is your next site to explore the greatness of ancient Egyptian religion in the hearts of the people and how much they dedicated to their spiritual life. Lunch and dinner are served aboard your Luxor to Aswan Nile Cruise and overnight at Aswan.

Day 5: Disembarkation - Sharm El Sheik
