Itinerary

Day 1: Overnight In Luxor

On your first day, you will be picked up from <u>Alexandria Port</u> by a representative to be transferred to Cairo International Airport to catch your domestic flight to Luxor.

The <u>Valley of The Kings</u> is a royal burial ground for pharaohs and high priests. From the tomb evidence, it appears that people were promised a life in the afterlife if they were good in this world.

The two massive stone statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III were made from blocks of quartzite sandstone that came from the north of Luxor.

The Mortuary <u>Hatshepsut Temple</u> was one of the most beautiful temples in Egypt. It consisted of three terraces and a garden. It took fifteen years to be constructed. Lunch will be served on an island, so your tour includes boat trips in the Nile River.

The <u>Karnak Temple</u> is impressive because it is the largest temple complex ever built by man, and it was created by the combined efforts of many ancient builders and pharaohs.

After touring the Luxor Temple, you will check into a five-star hotel for the night.

Day 2: From Luxor To Cairo and Return Back To Alexandria Port

After having a delicious breakfast, you'll be ready to check out. Then you'll catch your flight to Cairo to meet your tour guide.

The Giza Pyramids are one of the Seven Wonders of the World and are from 2400 BC. You will visit three main pyramids and six little pyramids at Giza, which are all from 2400 BC. This is a unique opportunity to see these ancient monuments and learn about their history.

The <u>the great Sphinx</u>, a magnificent limestone statue with a lion's body and a human head, is a symbol of power and wisdom. Legend has it that the Sphinx was created by Pharaoh Khafra, the owner of the second pyramid. This unique monument is a testament to the great Pharaoh's mastery of construction and engineering.

The Valley Temple is an imposing block of pink Aswan granite, its floor made of delicate alabaster. <u>The Valley Temple of King Chephren</u> is used for the mummification process, and it belongs to the famed Pyramids of Chephren.

If you have the time, it would be worth your while to have lunch at the Pyramids and then take a look

at the Nile view restaurant. Afterwards, you can continue your visit to the city.

The Egyptian Museum is one of the most important collections of Egyptian art in the world, and it's home to an extensive exhibit on <u>Tutankhamun</u>'s treasure trove, as well as other exhibits on ancient Egyptian art. It's a must-see for anyone interested in learning about this fascinating culture.

At the end of the day you will be transferred back to the port of Alexandria.
