Grand Egyptian Museum and Giza Pyramids Tour from Alexandria Port

Your <u>Cairo Top Tours</u> tour leader will pick you up from your cruise exit door in <u>Alexandria Port</u> and take you to enjoy your <u>Grand Egyptian Museum</u> and Giza Pyramids Tour. This tour will start with a visit to the popular <u>Plateau of Giza</u> and then you will visit the Great Pyramid of <u>Cheops</u>, one of the seven wonders of the ancient world and the pyramid of Chephren, the second reigning son of king Khufu since the first son and direct successor Djedef Re, built his pyramid in Abo-Rawash.

You will also visit the grand <u>Sphinx</u>, the tour extends to visit the Valley Temple or the mummification temple of King Chephren.

Then have lunch at a local restaurant and continue your Grand Egyptian Museum tour, which costs more than one billion American dollars to be accomplished as the largest museum in the world.

The museum houses masterpieces and artifacts from the various stages of the Pharaonic period.

At the end of the day, after ending your trip from our <u>Alexandria Shore Excursions</u>, you will be transferred back to Alexandria Port.
