Giza and Hawara pyramids from Alexandria Port

The Giza pyramids are perhaps the most iconic and well-known ancient monuments in the world. Located in Egypt, the pyramids were built around 4,500 years ago and were originally constructed as grand tombs for Pharaohs and their consorts. The three main pyramids at Giza were built by Pharaohs Khufu, Khafre, and Menkaure, while the smaller pyramid in the complex was built by Khufu's grandson, Djedefre. The Giza complex also includes <u>the Great Sphinx</u>, a giant limestone statue of a lion with a human head, which is believed to have been built to guard the entrance to the Khufu pyramid.

Imagine how fascinating it would be to visit The Hawara pyramid, one of the most popular tourist destinations in Egypt. It was built for Pharaoh Amenemhat III and is also known as the Black Pyramid. The Hawara pyramid is 102 meters tall and was built around 1850 BC. It has two chambers: the first chamber is the burial chamber of Pharaoh Amenemhat III, and the second chamber is the Queen's Chamber. The Hawara pyramid is one of the most fascinating tourist attractions in Egypt, and thousands of people visit it every year. It's definitely worth a visit!
