Itinerary

Tour to National Museum of Egyptian Civilization & Dahshour Pyramids from Alexandria port

You will be picked up from <u>Alexandria Port</u> early in the morning and travel directly to Cairo in a comfortable air-conditioned vehicle.

Let's begin our tour at <u>Dahshour</u>, an archaeological site five miles from Sakkara. Three pyramids can be found there: the Red Pyramid, the North Pyramid, and the Bent Pyramid.

The fourth dynasty's founder, Pharaoh Snefru, is both the owner of two pyramids, as well as Queen Hotep Heres, the owner of the third pyramid.

You'll be able to visit this location to see the Bent Pyramid, a pyramid with two levels that has a beautiful soft casing layer. The design and appearance of this pyramid is fascinating, which was an early attempt to create the Step pyramids' design In addition, you can see the queen's little pyramid here.

After that, stop at the <u>the Red Pyramid</u> or North pyramid. The earliest authentic and comprehensive pyramid in ancient Egypt is this one. You will learn about how Old Kingdom royal tomb architecture evolved. You may also visit the confined tunnel to the chamber of this pyramid, which is quite an experience.

We'll have lunch at a local restaurant, and then we'll take you on a tour of the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization. This museum is devoted to Egyptian civilization, and during your visit you'll see some of the most significant and largest antiquities collections in the world. You'll be able to see artifacts from the earliest times up to the present day, and the museum has areas for temporary exhibits as well as an exhibition on the growth of contemporary Cairo.
