Then we will start driving to Luxor in a comfortable, air-conditioned car, for about three hours. Start by visiting <u>the Karnak Temple</u> Complex, the largest man-made religious complex the world has ever seen.

And admire the giant pillared hall. Next, you will cross the Nile to enjoy a tour of the West Bank of

Luxor to visit the two colossal statues of Amenhotep III, famous for <u>the Colossus of Memnon</u>, and then visit <u>the Valley of the Kings</u>, where 62 pharaohs of the New Kingdom are buried.

Including the famous Tutankhamun, Thutmose III and the legendary Ramesses II, these tombs are cut from the mountain, lavishly decorated with exquisite paintings and filled with treasures that the pharaohs planned to enjoy in the afterlife.

Continue Luxor trips from the port of Safaga to see <u>the Temple of Hatshepsut</u> known as Deir el-Bahari, the first female ruler in written history.

Then you will go to one of the famous local restaurants for lunch, and then you will make a Nile cruise to never forget to collect the best memories through the Nile Felucca for a while Half an hour and take the best memorial photos, then the guide will accompany you to return to the cruise in Safaga port again.
