what makes Luxor temple special is because the Luxor temple was not built in adoration to a god or to a god figure of the kings and pharaohs; instead, Luxor Temple was built in dedication to the rejuvenation of kingship, then you will be taken to the second spot which is the <u>Valley of kings</u> and queens. The valley was where most of the kings and queens were buried in order to get protected from the robbers who robbed the king's mummies and treasures.

Then transfer to the unusual site the Dra' Abu Al Naga, It was built in the era of the Pharaonic Dynasty 17, where the cartouches of King Thutmose I, one of the most important and famous kings of the Pharaohs, were discovered.

Move to <u>Madinet Habu temple</u>, The temple was named "Habu" in relation to the city of Habu in Luxor, while some say that the name Habu or Habu is for a Christian monk called Habu, as the second courtyard of the temple was used as a church for Christians in this area when Christianity entered. Last but not least the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, The Colossi of Memnon was meant to protect the Pharaoh's temple from evil. Even after the temple was destroyed by a severe earthquake, the Colossi of Memnon remains standing strong for thousands of years.
