Egyptian Museum and Saladin Citadel Tour from Sokhna Port

Upon your arrival in Cairo's Top Tour port, our representative will be waiting to welcome you and help you start your amazing tours of Cairo.

You will start your day by spending two hours touring the Egyptian Museum in <u>Cairo</u>, one of the world's largest and most valuable collections of Egyptian antiquities. This museum has a lot of sarcophagi from different dynasties, including those discovered inside the tomb of the golden Pharaoh <u>Tutankhamun</u>.

Tutankhamun was a great pharaoh of ancient kings who died young but is remembered throughout the ages for his wealth and the extraordinary possessions in his tomb. Not everyone is convinced that his death was unnatural, that he was murdered, but until now it was not known who killed him! ! But you can learn more about him in our Luxor travel guide.

We'll continue by moving to the <u>Citadel of Salah El-Din</u>, a unique and famous medieval fort occupying a central location in <u>Islamic Cairo</u>. With fascinating views of the whole beautiful area and hundreds of minarets and domes.

The Alabaster Mosque of Mohamed Ali is a beautiful place to visit, and it's only one stop on our tour of Cairo. The mosque was founded by a Turkish architect in 1805, and it looks very similar to the Blue Mosque in Istanbul. The ruler of Egypt at the time, Mohamed Ali Basha, made many reforms to the country in different fields, and the mosque is a perfect example of his work. When you enter the mosque, be prepared to be amazed by the wall cavity at the central dome and the painted windows. If you have enough time, you can also visit Khan El Khalili, Cairo's old bazaar, and experience the traditional life there.
