First, you will go to the Giza pyramids, Among the strangest things said about the wonders of the pyramids are the seeds stored in the pyramid for a period ranging from one to 5 days, increasing their size by 30 to 100%.

Then you will be transferred to <u>The Egyptian museum</u>, It is one of the largest and most famous international museums, located in the heart of the Egyptian capital, Cairo, on the northern side of Tahrir Square

and when you reach <u>Old Cairo</u>, You will be visiting Islamic sites as Amr ibn AlAss masjid and Christian sites in Cairo as the hanging church.
