The Great Pyramid of Khufu is the largest and most famous of the three pyramids, standing at a height of 147 meters and containing an estimated 2.3 million stone blocks. It is also the oldest of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World and the only one that still exists today.

In addition to the pyramids themselves, the Giza complex also includes a number of smaller pyramids and temples, as well as the Great Sphinx, a massive statue of a human-headed lion that is believed to date back to the reign of Khafre. The Giza Pyramids remain an important cultural and historical site.

There are three main chambers in the Giza pyramid: the King's Chamber, the Queen's Chamber, and the Grand Gallery. Since everyone is curious about what is inside the pyramid, we will take you there.
