Day 1: Arrival to Cairo

Upon your arrival to <u>Cairo International Airport</u> our representative will be waiting for your to transfer you to your hotel in Cairo, where he will be helping you with a smooth check-in before revising your **10 days luxury package to Egypt**.

Day 2: Pyramids and Cairo Tours

After breakfast on your first day, you will meet your tour guide at your hotel lobby to start your tour in Egypt

You'll get to see some of Egypt's most unique sites, like The Giza Pyramids, you will see the Great Pyramid of Cheops the biggest of the three pyramids, the middle pyramid of King Chephren which is also called (The second Pyramid), and the smallest and the third one which was built for the King Mycerinus to serve as a tomb. It took 20 years to be built.

Not only can you see some of the most impressive ancient monuments in Egypt, but you'll also be able to admire the <u>Great Sphinx of Giza</u> – a symbol of power and wisdom. Plus, its head is said to resemble the king Chephren.

If you're interested in taking a camel ride through Cairo, there's plenty of time to do so – and we can even help you take beautiful photos to remember the experience!

Then you will visit the Museum of Egyptian Antiquities where you'll be able to see a collection of unique artifacts that date back over two thousand years. Among these are 120,000 objects that are used as everyday tools and accessories by ancient Egyptians. Additionally, you'll be able to view huge coffins, huge statues, and King Tutankhamun's golden collection. This is a museum that will be a treasure trove of knowledge for you.

After a delicious lunch in a local restaurant, you'll continue your <u>Egypt day tours</u> with an amazing Coptic Cairo Tour. This tour includes six ancient churches, and the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary – one

of the oldest churches in old Cairo, And the <u>Abu Serga Church</u> which is an ancient church in Egypt that probably dates back to the 4th century. You'll also visit the ancient <u>the ancient Jewish Synagogue of Ben Ezra</u> which was originally a Christian church.

After your tour is complete, you'll be transferred to your hotel in Cairo.

Day 3: Alexandria Trip

Breakfast is the perfect way to start your day, and then travel to Alexandria from Cairo, an amazing city with a rich history. The <u>Citadel of Qaitbay</u> is a beautiful monument from the 15th century and is a perfect place to start your visit.

You will have a wonderful time exploring the <u>Catacombs of Kom El-Shoqafa</u> and the Pompey's Pillar which was built around 300 AD for the Roman emperor Diocletian and Roman ruins at the site, and the <u>Alexandria Bibliotheca</u> which is an important library in Alexandria and serves as a cultural center. You will have lunch and spend the night in the Alexandria hotel.

Day 4: Alamein World War II Cemetery and Military Museum

After breakfast, leave Cairo for your <u>El-Alamein day tour from Cairo</u>. On this day tour from Cairo, you'll visit the Federal Cemetery, home to many cemeteries and memorials commemorating war victims from many different countries.

There is much to see and do in this city - a church, mosque, museum, and cemeteries, all within close proximity to one another. In addition, there is a military museum with extensive displays on the history of war. You'll be able to explore the Italian, German, and Australian cemeteries in El Alamein while you're here.

Finally, you'll be brought back to Cairo.

Day 5: Fly to Luxor - East Bank Tours

You will be transferred to <u>Cairo International Airport</u> to catch your flight to <u>Luxor</u> (Thebes). You will visit Luxor Temple, which was dedicated to the worship of the god "Amun" and his wife "Mut" and their son "Khonsu".

After touring the El Karnak Temple complex built by King Amenhotep IV at the end of the day, you will be able to check in to your hotel in Luxor and overnight there.

You can book one of our Luxor day tours in the evening.

Day 6: Luxor West Bank Tours

On your sixth day of the <u>Luxor West Bank Tours</u>, you will visit some of the most impressive and historic sites in Egypt. These include the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, home to 63 royal tombs of the New Kingdom's kings and pharaohs, and the Temple of Ramses III at Medinet Habu, an impressive relic of ancient Egyptian architecture that is a testament to the power and influence of Ramses II. This tour will be an unforgettable experience, and you will be able to learn a great deal about ancient Egyptian culture and history. After touring the city sights, you will finish your trip by visiting the Colossal Statue of Amenhotep III, also known as the <u>Colossi Memnon</u>. It is a magnificent statue of the King that stands 18 meters high.

Then you will be transferred back to your hotel in Luxor.

Day 7: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

After breakfast, you will head to <u>Temple of Edfu</u> to admire its beauty and luxury. It was built in the 2nd century BC and dedicated to the god Horus. After visiting the temples, you will continue your journey by visiting the Kom Ombo temple, located high on a hill overlooking the east bank of the Nile.

The temple's impressive foundation dates back to ancient times, when Ptolemy VI honored the crocodile god Sobek and one of the forms of the God Horus, which was worshipped at Kom Ombo.

Transfer you to your hotel in Aswan for check-in and overnight.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 8: Aswan Sighteeing Tours

After breakfast, take a tour of <u>Aswan day tours</u> and be transported to some of the most impressive ancient monuments in Egypt and Sudan. Then, visit the <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u> in Egypt, which was 1508-1458 BC. Built by <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u> and made from a single piece of stone. Finally, visit the Temple of Philae, which was built in honor of the goddess Isis and built by Ptolemy II and completed by the Roman Emperors.

Overnight in Aswan.

Day 9: Abu Simbel Temples

After breakfast, visit the <u>Abu Simbel Temples</u>, built by Ramesses II and depicting the ancient Egyptian wonders of astronomy, engineering, and architecture. His two temples carved into the mountain at Abu Simbel by a woman, Ramesses II.

This splendid temple is dedicated to four powerful deities, and it's also named after the king who was particularly devoted to it. The smaller temple is dedicated to the queen who was the king's favorite.

You will be transferred to Aswan Airport to take your flight back to Cairo and spend the night in a Cairo hotel.
